

Camp Discount Eligibility:



Child must be age 6-12 (child can be age 5, if they are entering kindergarten this school year), a Duval county resident **AND** provide **ONE** of the below proof documents.

1. Special Need or special education student documented by:
 - a. A current diagnosis report from a medical or psychological professional verifying that the child would require and IEP if enrolled in the public school system or
 - b. A McKay Scholarship (as **documented by a form from the school with the child's name and current school year date**).

2. Community Eligibility Student: Students enrolled in one of the Duval County Public Schools that are participating in the National Student Lunch and School Breakfast Program called Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) - **documented by a student report card from one of the following schools** Obtain Free Lunch Approval Letter 904-732-5145.
